



**Left:** The Dormition Cathedral Theatre in Vladimir.





at the Camp of Batu Khan (1883)



### Abram Petrovich Gannibal

A Moor by fact recognized as a Russian Nobleman, Military Engineer and General. Kidnapped as a child and presented as a gift to 'Peter the Great'. He was raised in the Emperor's household, and eventually rose to become a prominent member of the Imperial Court. Also, the great-grandfather of Alexander Pushkin. He is mentioned in J.A.
